NOTICE TO NEW STUDENTS

This notice serves to advise all new students of the following:

a) Lectures

Lectures for New Block Students will run from **2–6 March 2026**.

Lectures for New Conventional Students will run from **9 March - 29 May 2026**

b) Registration and Accommodation

- **New Conventional Students** are expected to check in on **Sunday, 22 February 2026 from 1400 hours**. The Orientation Programme for New Conventional Students has been circulated separately.
- **New Block Students** are expected to check in on **Sunday, 1 March 2026 from 1400 hours**. Registration and certificate verification will take place on **Monday, 2 March 2026 between 0800 hours and 1000 hours** at the Recreation Centre. Lectures will follow thereafter until Friday, 6 March 2026.
- The latest check-in time for all students is **1800 hours**.
- Students must bring **original and certified copies** of all academic certificates.

Students are required to pay at least **60% of the prescribed fees** to facilitate registration.

Only registered students who have paid the **full accommodation fees** will be allocated accommodation.

University bank details remain as previously communicated. Payments may also be made via swipe at the Bursar's Office on campus. **No cash payments will be accepted.**

c) Transport

Transport arrangements for new students will be communicated by the Student Affairs Division in due course.

d) Health-Related Issues

Students with chronic medical conditions are advised to bring adequate medication and report their condition to the Chief Nursing Sister upon arrival.

e) Other Matters

Cooking in the halls of residence is strictly prohibited. Meals will be available for purchase at the Dining Hall. Students are required to bring one cup, a plate, and cutlery for personal use in the Dining Hall.

Students should also bring their own bedding.
